

Pastor's Corner

The Church Mourns, the Church Trusts

This week, our hearts are heavy as we mourn the passing of Pope Francis, a true apostle of Divine Mercy. His life of simplicity, humility, and tireless

compassion has left a profound imprint on the Church. His death has created an immense emptiness, felt deeply by Catholics around the world who loved him for his witness to Christ's love and mercy.

The funeral Mass, held with poignant simplicity at St. Peter's Square, reflected the very spirit of Pope Francis. Despite the global mourning, the liturgy remained humble, in accordance with his wishes. Over 100 cardinals, 400 bishops, and more than 3,000 priests concelebrated the Mass. An estimated 150,000 faithful filled St. Peter's Square and surrounding areas to pay their respects. Heads of state and royalty from across the globe were present, along with official delegations from more than 80 countries and all continents, representing both the Church's spiritual reach and Pope Francis' global impact. And yet, the solemnity and modesty of the event remained—a true echo of the man we now entrust to God's eternal mercy.

Now, the world is abuzz with speculation: who will be the next Pope? News outlets and social media are flooded with predictions and rumors. Yet as Catholics, we are called to something different: to trust. We believe that the Church belongs to Christ, and that the Holy Spirit—who has guided the Church through every century—will once again enlighten the hearts of the cardinals as they elect the next Successor of Peter.

Let us not be drawn into worldly anxiety or speculation. Instead, let us entrust ourselves to the loving providence of God. The Holy Spirit, who was promised to remain with the Church until the end of time, will never fail her. Let us pray earnestly for the cardinals, for the Church, and for the one whom God Himself is preparing to lead His people.

May our trust be firm, our hope unwavering, and our love for the Church renewed in these sacred days. And please, do not forget to pray for me, for our bishop, and for all the priests of the Archdiocese of Regina as we enter our annual retreat from **Monday, May 5 to Friday,**May 9. May this time of silence and renewal bear fruit for the pastoral mission entrusted to us.




